VICAR'S MESSAGE



Greetings to all in the holy name of Triune God,
The month of September is very special for Orthodox Churches. It marks the beginning of the ecclesiastical calendar. September 14th is celebrated as the feast of Holy Cross. From September 14th till Easter it is the period of Holy Cross (Sleeba Kalam). It is a journey we accomplish meditating the importance of cross and the passion of Christ in our day to day life. The feast of Holy Cross was first observed in Rome before the end of the seventh century.

It commemorates the recovery of the Holy Cross, which had been placed on Mt. Calvary by St. Helena and preserved in Jerusalem, but then had fallen into the hands of Chosroas, King of the Persians. The precious relic was recovered and returned to Jerusalem by Emperor Heraclius in 629. The lessons from the Breviary tell us that Emperor Heraclius carried the Cross back to Jerusalem on his shoulders. He was clothed with costly garments and with ornaments of precious stones. But at the entrance to Mt. Calvary a strange incident occurred. Try as hard as he would, he could not go forward. Zacharias, the Bishop of Jerusalem, then said to the astonished monarch: "Consider, O Emperor, that with these triumphal ornaments you are far from resembling Jesus carrying His Cross." The Emperor then put on a penitential garb and continued the journey.

Today when we celebrate the feast of Holy Cross, the words of Bishop Zacharias resonate our ear now and then. During the Sleeba Kalam we, alike Emperor Heraclius carry the precious Cross of our Lord that we recovered at the time of our baptism at Mount Calvary. However we also try to carry the Holy cross clothed with costly garments and with ornaments of precious stones. Often this feast is only symbolic and has ecclesiastical obligations. That is why the harder we try, we fail to proceed our journey and place our cross at the Mt. Calvary. The time has come to reconsider our life-style and renew our spiritual commitment. With penitential garb and penitent life only our carrying of cross has its meaning, otherwise all our feasts and fasts become meaningless and fail to reach the destiny.

When Moses lifted up the bronze serpent over the people, it was a foreshadowing of the salvation through Jesus when He was lifted up on the Cross. Our Mother Church sings of the triumph of the Cross, the instrument of our redemption. To follow Christ we must take up His cross, follow Him and become obedient until death, even if it means death on the cross. We identify with Christ on the Cross and become co-redeemers, sharing in His cross.

On the occasion of the celebration of the blessed virgin mother Mary the mother of God (theotokos-God Bearer) and the Church annual convention, the Church as a whole look forward to imitate the faith, commitment, life and holiness of the Mother Mary. Like Mother Mary who is not only the God Bearer but also the true Apostolos, Disciple and a true witness to display the correct understanding of Cross through her life. When we come closer to Mother's bosom then only we can hear the heartbeat of her Son and His salvation in true sense.

The cultural festival of Kerala, "Onam" also falls in this month. It is the ultimate symbol of integrity, sacrifice and unity. Let these auspicious occasions may bear true fruits in our life according to the true meaning that they reflect. This is my final wish and my prayer as I depart from Kuwait on 11th September.

I take this opportunity to thank God for the best part of my life to serve you for the last three years. I thank H.G Dr. Joseph Mar Dionysius our beloved metropolitan for his prayerful support and faith in me. I also thank Vicars, Rev. Fr. Jose Mathew and the most revered and respected, Fr. Raju Thomas for the support, guidance and help provided to me. Special thanks to the parish Managing Committees from 2013-17; Church Managing Committee members Mr. Sabu T George, Mr. Shaji Abraham and Mr Jaison P Varghese, Members and office bearers of Spiritual and Charitable Organisations of the Parish, Sunday School teachers, Prayer group Secretaries, Preachers and all beloved members of this parish especially the lovable little angels. I extend my gratitude to all those who assisted me in the altar and in the Choir. My sincere thanks to our office assistant Monechen, who was a great help to me in all these years. I also acknowledge the Members and Vicars of St. Basil, St. Stephen's, St. Thomas Orthodox Church Ahmadi and the KEFC member churches for their warmth and support. Sincere thanks to Rev Immanuel Garibh, Mr. K.P Koshi, Mr. Roy Yohannan and all other support staff of NECK for their goodwill. I will be doing injustice if I may not remember Mr. Shaji Elenjickal, whose timely help during my crisis had helped me to stay in Kuwait so far.
