Matthew 4:17 (NLT) From then on, Jesus began to preach, "Turn from your sins and turn to God, because the Kingdom of Heaven is near."



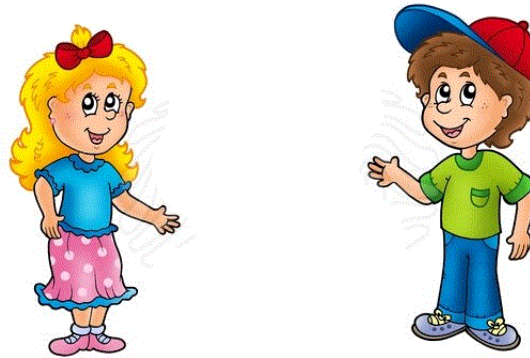

ABSOLUTION

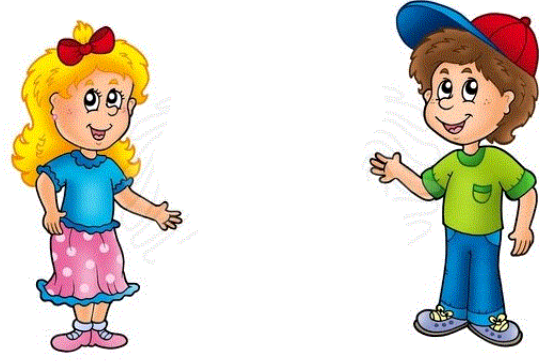

Holy Communion

Holy Communion is the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ given with bread and wine, instituted by Christ himself for us such that our sins will be forgiven.

Truly, truly, I say unto you, unless you eat of the flesh of the Son of man and drink of His blood, you have no life in you. (St. John 6:48-56)

And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me.'
(St. Luke 22:19)





- 1. Every small wrong that we do is a SIN – which separates us from God.**
- 2. If we sin, we need to be sorry and REPENT to God to have mercy on us.**
- 3. We should receive ABSOLUTION as a preparation for Holy Communion.**
- 4. By receiving HOLY COMMUNION, we receive the flesh and blood of Jesus and UNITE in Him.**
