It is your sins that separate you from God. (Isaiah59:2)


The wages of sin is death. (Rom. 6:23).


Those who sin cannot be true Christians, but are of the devil. (1 John 3:8)

Lets say sorry to God and decide not to do it again


Matthew 4:17 (NLT) From then on, Jesus began to preach, "Turn from your sins and

ABSOLUTION


Confession is agreeing with God that our thoughts, actions, behaviors and attitudes are against His word and will.

If we confess our sins, He who is faithful and just, will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all wickedness. (1 John1:9)



Ask God to have mercy on you when the priest places his hand on your head.





Holy Communion

Holy Communion is the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ given with bread and wine, instituted by Christ himself for us such that our sins will be forgiven.

Truly, truly, I say unto you, unless you eat of the flesh of the Son of man and drink of His blood, you have no life in you. (St. John 6:48-56)

And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my

body given for you; do this in remembrance of me.'

(St.Luke 22:19)







- 1. Every small wrong that we do is a <u>SIN</u> which separates us from God.
- 2. If we sin, we need to be sorry and <u>REPENT</u> to God to have mercy on us.
- 3. We should receive <u>ABSOLUTION</u> as a preparation for Holy Communion.
- 4. By receiving <u>HOLY COMMUNION</u>, we receive the flesh and blood of Jesus and UNITE in Him.
