THE UNCREATED LIGHT AT THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST

On Mount Tabor when Jesus showed his Glory to the living and dead, a tremendous brilliance shrouded the whole scene. Here the 'cloud of unknowing' signifies the unseen presence of God. Moses had confronted this brilliance enshrouded in the cloud on Mount Sinai. Of course, it was too much for him! On the Mount of Transfiguration the ordinary disciples could not stand the overwhelming brilliance of the Son of God, they physically fell down. Only Moses and Elijah could espy the scene and talk to Jesus face to face. The Eastern spiritual tradition would call this tremendous brilliance as "Uncreated Light", which could be accessible to "yogins" and ascetics as they climb the "Ladder of Ascent". This undefined and inexplicable light lightens up everything and everyone. It is the true light that "enlightens every human being" (Jn 1:9)

The Resurrection of Jesus is in many ways the festival of this undying and uncreated light which shows every man his "way" to be followed in life. This is the Light of New Life, offered to every human by Jesus Christ, who has defeated sin, Satan and death through his suffering, death and resurrection.

At the long last, here is the solution to the problem of death and perdition. In the language of the Liturgy, the enemy death has been destroyed, Satan, the enemy of human kind, has been vanquished, and the burden of sin has been removed. This victory has been won for us through the tremendous suffering and death of our Lord.

Now, in this 'brave Clearness' of the midday of the Resurrection, man can see himself clearly in the proper and clear dimensions. For centuries, man had lost his sense of being, because his "distance" from God. He has now received back his life and blessings freely, without paying for it. But the fact is that someone had to pay the heavy price for the salvation of man; and Jesus did it in his body. It is this awareness that makes us remorseful about our misdeeds and makes us grateful to God for this free gift.

The Light at Jesus' Resurrection is the light of the new life. It is said that God started creation, by first creating light. Resurrection is also interpreted as the creation of the New Humanity in Christ. Here, the New Creation starts with the brilliance of the Uncreated Light at the dawn of Resurrection. As the light of God dawns on us it starts lightening up our entire life and relationships. Darkness stands for sin and ignorance, neglect and irresponsible life. Light is the opposite of all these.

To comprehend the magnitude and significance of the Resurrection light, we need to look at the Disciples of Christ. They were mostly uneducated and ignorant. Jesus was trying hard to teach them the values of the Kingdom and the overbearing Love of God. They reached a moment of confusion, sense of loss and fear. The message of Resurrection comes to them as another "jolt". It seems they were not prepared to receive this

overwhelming news. In due course, with exhortations from Jesus and getting strengthened by the Holy Spirit, the Light entered their soul, and they could welcome the Gospel into their being. Then, they were ready for any sacrifice for the sake of their Lord. They are not scared of death and pain any longer, now they have a reason to be alive and to die. Now life has a new meaning for them. It is that now, life makes sense! The major problem with our times is that for many people, rich and poor, life does not make sense. Now that enigma is solved: "I live and die for Jesus". The friendship of the One who died for my sake is inevitable for me. He lives for ever. He has assured us that he has overcome the world, and that because he lives, we also live.

The uncreated light of Resurrection speaks volumes to all. Let us bow down and worship the Resurrected Lord. He is the Captain and Champion of our life, and we need him, every day of our life!

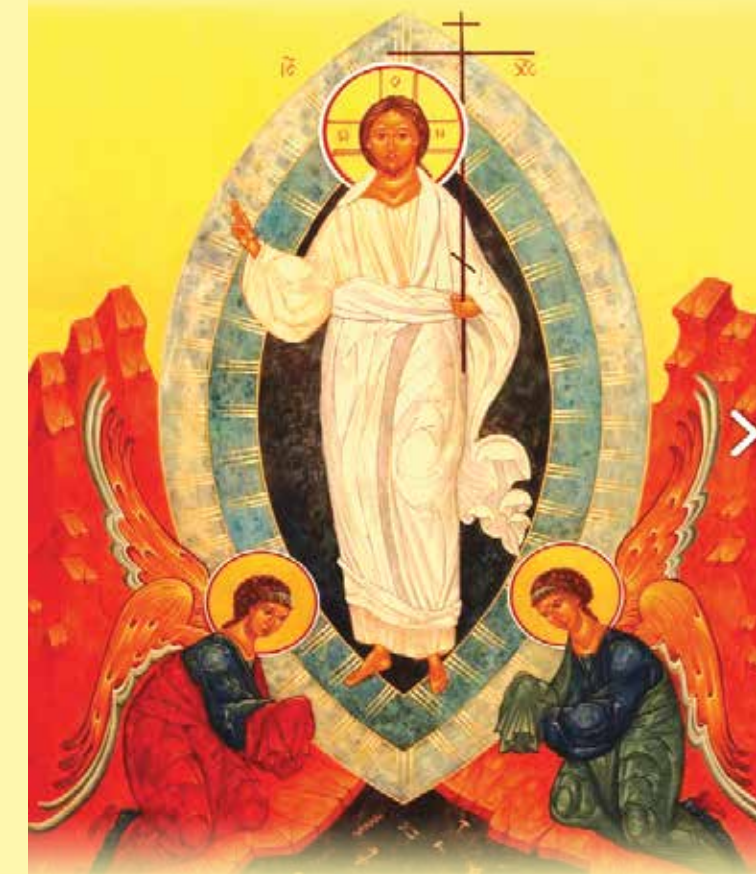
