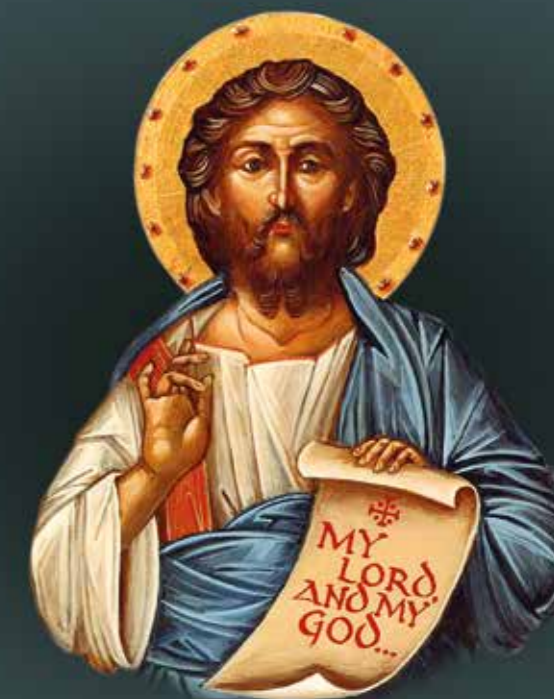

VISITING CLERGY'S MESSAGE

Dear Beloved in Christ Greeting to you all in the name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ. The life of a Christian is a journey to attain the place, which the Lord has set, and to reach the land the lord has promised.

This journey is not that easy. We have to carry the cross on our back on the way. Recently we have commemorated the feast of the holy apostles, who have journeyed and reached the Promised Land. Let their intercession be to us a stronghold and refuge.

In the beginning of the month of July, we specially remember the martyrdom of our Holy Father and apostle St. Thomas. According to historical records, St. Thomas was allegedly martyred at Chennai (St. Thomas Mount) in AD 72, July 3rd and his body was interred in Mylapore and his relics were taken then to Edessa. The holy church celebrates this day as a feast.

When we remember the early life of St. Thomas as a disciple of Jesus. We recollect the event occurred after the resurrection of Jesus and for that; he was called 'Doubting Thomas'. However, followed by that, we come across his great words of declaration of faith 'My Lord and My God'. Through this Thomas, the doubter became Thomas the model believer, an example for each one of us. He is a great beacon of right for all of us, as we are called to cry out with him, My Lord and My God!

These are some of the most profound powerful words in the entirety of the word. St. Thomas carried these words very closer to his heart and has brought to us, the people of India. We many a times only remember the churches built up by the apostle and forget the great proclamation of faith by him. Let us meditate these days on the words of our father and apostle St. Thomas.

These words contain what is perhaps the single most important truth that has been revealed to the world, that the Lord Jesus Christ is God. But we do not remember St. Thomas primarily for making this confession of the Lords divinity. We know him today as doubting Thomas. We use the name to refer to people who are too sceptical for their own good, who refuse to believe anything unless they can touch it and see it. St. Thomas was only able to make his confession when he saw and touched the Lord. But the Lord said "Because you have seen me, Thomas you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed "(St. John 20:29) .Unlike St. Thomas, we do not physically see the Lord or touch him, we are asked to believe in him without actually having physical proof that he is there, He has risen and He is God.

Faith is defined as an internal acknowledgement of truth and we cannot force ourselves to see the truth in something that we do not understand. The physical proof of the existence of the risen Lord and his spirit in our midst is our life itself. But still at some point of hardships in

our life we start doubting the presence of God around us. Faith is the basic ingredient to begin a relationship with God. We need to have a strong relationship with God, which is possible only through extreme faith in him. It is by faith we understand that the world was made by God's command so what we see was made by someone that cannot be seen. It was by faith that Abel offered God a better sacrifice than Cain did. God said He was pleased with the gifts of Abel offered and called Abel a good man because of his faith. Abel died, but through his faith, he is still speaking (Hebrew 11:3-4). God is pleased with the one who is strong in his or her faith, which is the basic and foremost need for the life of a Christian. Without faith, no one can please God. Anyone who come to God must believe that he is real and that he rewards those who truly want to find him (Heb 11:6).

We have many examples of the life of our great forefathers who by their faith attained glory and blessing from God. So let us all who are called as St. Thomas Christians adopt the great proclamation For ourselves and come to God calling him 'My God and My lord'. Let us all built an intimate relationship with our creator.

May the intercession of our father and apostle St. Thomas be a guard and refuge for each one of our family, our church, the society and us.
